2. Special Tours

We will introduce to you our medical and billing system, facilities, what we offer to support our foreign patients etc. We can arrange the tour on the date and time of your request if a staff is available.

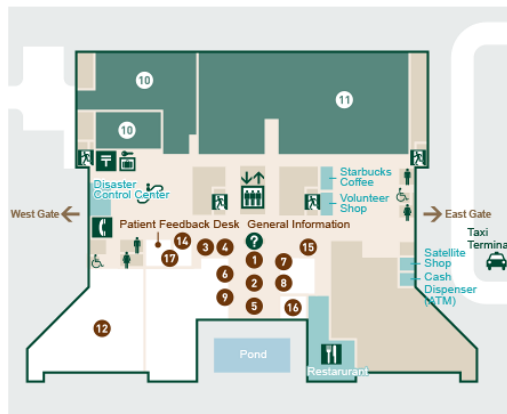
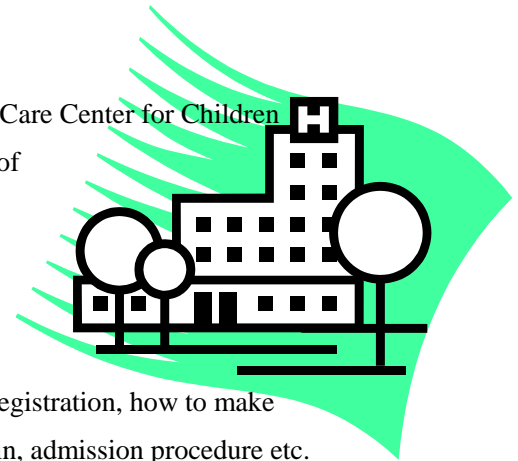


Main building
