Immuno-Rheumatology Center provides most advanced medical care for patients with various autoimmune and auto-inflammatory disorders. There are three American Board certified Rheumatologists (Fellowship at Yale University, New York University and Cleveland Clinic) who received awards from American College of Rheumatology, an American Board certified Allergist, vasculitis specialist (completed Vasculitis Fellowship at Cleveland Clinic, a pediatric rheumatologist, Rheumatologist with PhD of Chinese herbal medicine and Musculoskeletal ultrasound specialists with Trainer and Advanced certificate by EULAR. The Chief of the Center, in addition to the official training at Yale University, also have experience to practice in Paris for eight years.

We provide broadest rheumatological and allergological medicine with the various background of our staff.

Comprehensive teaching of clinical immunology is given to our rotators as it is crucial to understand pathogenesis of all kinds of medical fields. Everyday morning round is held in English to discuss all of inpatients and in the afternoon students can spend time to work on the projects related to the discussion which is chosen by themselves.
