Urology deals with a variety of problems in urogenital organs such as tumors, stones, infections, and voiding dysfunction and so on. Department of Urology, St. Luke's International Hospital, offers mainly surgical treatment for them, especially minimally invasive surgery such as robotic/laparoscopic surgery and endoscopic surgery for benign prostate hyperplasia (BPH). We have done more than 600 cases of robot-assisted radical prostatectomy and more than 1000 cases of holmium-laser enucleation of the prostate (HoLEP) which is a new standard treatment for BPH.
