- Sent by postal mail to your residence (shipping fee: ¥450)
- Certificates will take 4 business days before they are completed (mailed certificates will require an additional 2-3 days)
 - Tested: Monday → Issued: Thursday; Tested: Tuesday → Issued: Friday; Tested: Friday → Issued: The following Monday (Issuing Hours: 2:00pm – 4:00pm)
 - For those traveling to Hawaii, your certificate will take 3 days (including the testing day) to be issued. (Issuing hours: 8:30am – 4:00pm)

Precautions for receiving the test

- Those applicable under the above questionnaire may undergo an examination covered by insurance either the following day or later. (Because your necessity for the PCR test will be determined by the doctor during your examination, you may not be eligible for the test in some cases.)
- Some people have the novel coronavirus even when they do not have symptoms. Also, there are times when tests come out as positive even if the patient does not actually have the virus. For those who test positive for the virus, this hospital will call you and instruct you on speaking with a doctor and/or other actions.
